


Life will go a little bit easier...if you choose direct deposit for your tax refund, like the millions of taxpayers already using this valuable service.

Working with your credit union, the IRS will transmit your tax refund directly to your credit union account. Direct deposit is:

- **Quick**—according to the IRS, direct deposit of your return enables the IRS to deliver your refund *up to 3 weeks earlier* than if you were to receive it by mail. The money goes directly into your account and you can put your tax refund to work right away.
- **Safe**—there is no check to get lost or stolen
- **Easy**—there's no need to arrange for a deposit or to make a special trip to your credit union.

Include your credit union routing number and your account information directly on your 1040 form in the section labeled "Refund."
